

Clarifications to Request for Proposal No. RFP/KGD6/2022/001 (AMENDMENT) (“RFP”)

30 March 2023

Please refer to RIL and BPEAL’s Notice Inviting Offer (“NIO”) dated 29 December 2022 and Request for Proposal No. RFP/KGD6/2022/001 (AMENDMENT) (“RFP”) for sale of Gas from Gas Fields in Block KG-DWN-98/3 (“KG D6”). Following clarifications are provided pursuant to various queries received from the Bidders on the Request for Proposal No. RFP/KGD6/2022/001 (AMENDMENT) (“RFP”) from prospective bidders:

1. In case a Bidder is nominated as an aggregator/reseller by Department of Fertiliser (DoF), Government of India (GoI) for procurement of HP-HT gas for Fertiliser sector, such Bidder can register separately under Fertiliser sector category on e-Bidding Platform i.e. one for its own requirement and another as an aggregator/reseller for HP-HT gas for Fertiliser companies, subject to following conditions:
 - a. Bidder is required to submit documentary evidence(s) in support of such nomination by DoF to act as aggregator/reseller of HP-HT gas for Fertiliser sector.
 - b. Bidder is required to submit all requisite documents specified under Section 3 (iv) of this RFP at the time of application for registration in the bidding process (refer Section 7.2.1 of this RFP).
 - c. Post receiving all requisite documents and verification by mjunction, the determination of Maximum Bid Volume for such separate registrations shall be as follows:
 - i. Mjunction shall determine Maximum Bid Volume for first registration using Net-worth and the gas procurement criteria by applying computation specified under Section 3(iv)(e) of the RFP.
 - ii. Any remaining values under each eligibility criteria shall be considered by mjunction for second registration of the Bidder, by again applying computation specified under Section 3(iv)(e) of the RFP and determine the Maximum Bid Volume for such second registration of the Bidder.
 - iii. Mjunction will notify the Bidder through email confirming its Maximum Bid Volume under such separate registrations after summation of ‘Maximum Bid Volume’ determined corresponding to each registration.
 - iv. Subsequently, the Bidder shall follow the procedure indicated in Section 3(v) of the RFP w.r.t providing bifurcation of its Maximum Bid Volume for such multiple registration against each registration of the Bidder to mjunction.

For example, if mjunction has notified Maximum Bid Volume of 95,00,000 SCMD (combined for two registrations) to the Bidder then the Bidder can intimate the bifurcation of its Maximum Bid Volume 95,00,000 SCMD as for one registration, say 50,00,000 SCMD mentioning in email to mjunction its use for Fertiliser sector and other registration 45,00,000 SCMD for its own requirement to mjunction or any such combination thereof.

Further, if such Bidder wishes to bifurcate its aforesaid 45,00,000 SCMD (e.g.) into multiple registrations, it can do separate registrations as per Section 3(v) and Section 5 (xiii)(a) of this RFP.

All such bifurcated volume shall then become the Maximum Bid Volume of the Bidder under its each registration and shall be notified to the Bidder by mjunction through email.

- d. It is clarified that Bidder shall be required to make separate submissions of the requisite documents for technical evaluation as specified in Section 7.2.2 of this RFP for each registration as mentioned in Section 7.2.1 of this RFP. Such a Bidder shall also provide a separate Security Deposit (as specified in Section 7.2.2.1 (ii) of this RFP) for each registration.
 - e. Such Bidder shall ensure that it shall sell Gas which is purchased under its registration for Fertiliser sector only to the Fertiliser companies..
2. In reference to Section 7.2.2 A (ii) and (iii) of the RFP, Bidders are required to upload duly signed/attested scanned copies of RFP No. RFP/KGD6/2022/001 (AMENDMENT) (and amendments if any) and GSPA uploaded on 30 March 2023.

Except the addendums and clarifications as notified, all other terms and conditions of RFP remain unchanged.
